RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

For participation in the Big Sky 4 Wheelers trail ride event, the signer of this form hereby agrees to release and hold harmless and owners, sponsors, trail guides, workers, and owners of both public and private land where Big Sky 4 Wheelers event is held. This shall also include officers, directors, agents and employees of Big Sky 4 Wheelers. The above shall also be released from negligent act or omission and shall also include any loss damage or cost incurred due to participation in the event. The participant shall understand and assume full responsibility for themselves and their passengers and risk for any property damage, injury or death while participating in this event. In signing this release, each participant hereby agrees to the following:

- (A) That the owner/operator certifies that he/she has inspected this vehicle and that the vehicle is in good working order.
- (B) That each participant has informed himself/herself about the event and the trails involved in the event.
- (C) That he/she has read all the foregoing Releases and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement.
- (D) Participants acknowledge that trail riding is hazardous, dangerous, and unpredictable
- (E) The signer of the registration form assumes all liability for their passengers, their vehicle, and any damage caused by him/her.

Four trail runs:

Snow Kings: 37 inch or larger tires, locked front and rear, Winch, Tow hooks, recovery gear and Safety equipment.

Powder Hounds: 33 inch or larger tires, Lockers and a winch, tow hooks and Safety equipment are recommended.

Wolf Hunt: Basic stock or modified vehicles should have recovery gear and Safety equipment.

Side by Side: should have good tires or tracks. Trail runs to be decided by number of participants and capabilities of machines.
